Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) is compulsory for international students studying in Australia.

- › It covers international students for certain medical costs (e.g. doctor's visits or admission to hospital).
- › Extra cover is available for an additional fee.

The Australian Government estimates that the average living costs for an international student is A\$24,505. This pays for food, accommodation, telephone, gas, electricity, transport and entertainment.

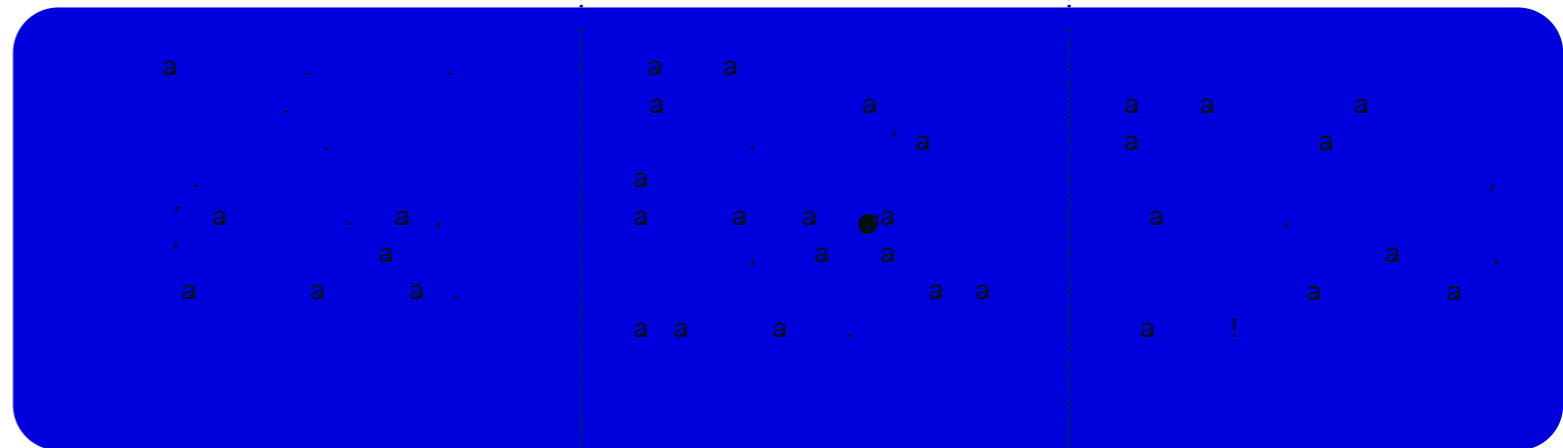

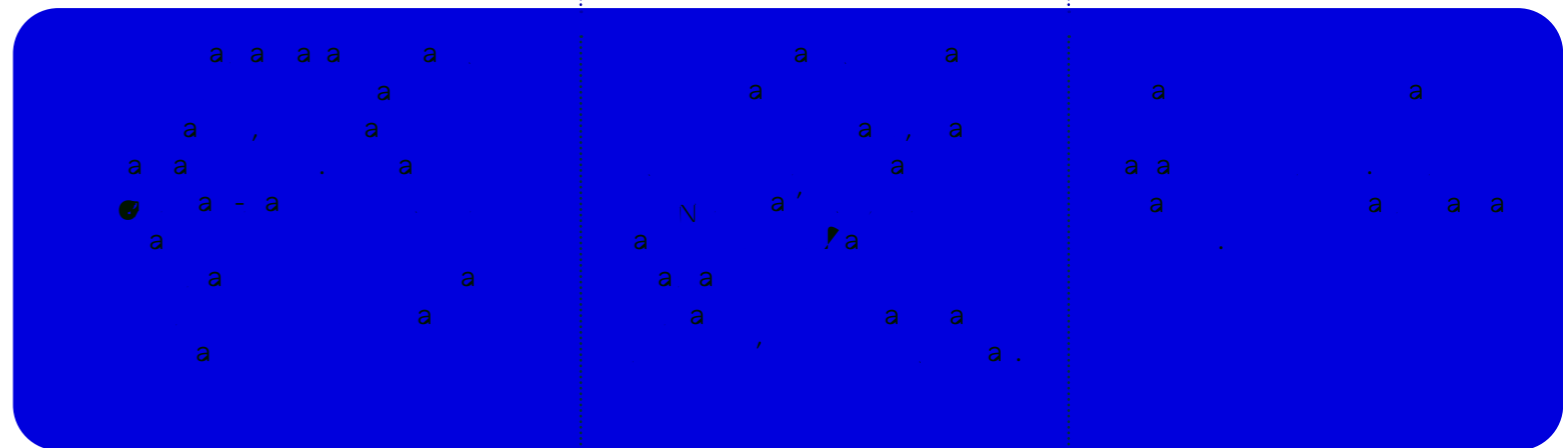

5. Upon Successful Application

If your application is successful, we will send you an Offer Letter offering you a place in the course.

6. Pay Fees

On receipt of the Offer Letter and upon signing the Student Agreement you will need to pay your tuition fees and the Overseas Student Health Cover if applicable. Please refer to the payment details as outlined in the Letter of Offer.

7. Apply for Student Visa (International Students)

On receipt of the fees, we will forward an official Confirmation of Enrolment that is needed for you to apply for a Student Visa. All international students must apply for and obtain a Student Visa from an appropriate Australian Government office before leaving for Australia. Please refer to the Department of Home Affairs website: www.homeaffairs.gov.au for further information regarding how to lodge a Student Visa. The general conditions required for a Student Visa to be issued are as follows:

- › Letter from us indicating acceptance of application
- › Confirmation of Enrolment after the respective fees have been paid
- › Health check-up as required by regulations
- › Proof of financial support
